Ex Parte—Elisha Warfield, Nathaniel A. Ware, Catharine Ann Warfield and Thomas B. Warfield.

Nathaniel A. Ware was father of Catharine Ann Warfield and she was the wife of Elisha. On Dec. 20, 1838 Nathaniel A. Ware conveyed to Thomas Warfield of Lexington, Ky., in trust for Catharine Ann and her children, certain lands in Washington Co. Miss. and Chicot Co. Ark. Children of Elisha and Catharine Ann Warfield: Nathaniel W., Eleanor P., Thos. G. Percy, Mary R., Catharine J. and Lloyd E. Warfield, all citizens of State of Kentucky.
