less than eighteen years of age, and who is lineally descended from a man or woman who, with unfailing loyalty to the cause
of American Independence, served as a sailor, or as a soldier or civil officer in one of the several Colonies or States, or in the
United Colonies or States, or as a recognized patriot, or rendered material aid thereto; provided the applicant is personally
acceptable to the Society." (Constitution, Article III, Section 1.)

Date of marriage may be substituted for dates of birth and death where such date proves the soldier to have been living
during the Revolution and of a suitable age for service.

Applicant further says that the said James Grimes (name of
ancestor from whom eligibility is derived) is the ancestor mentioned in the foregoing application, and that the statements
hereinafter set forth are true to the best of her knowledge and belief.

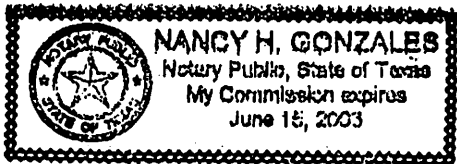
