# ANCESTOR'S SERVICES

The said Samuel Boone, Sr. who resided during the American Revolution at SC Camden Dist assisted in establishing American Independence, while acting in the capacity of furnished a substitute for military service (his own son Samuel Boone (Jr)) FS SC

My ancestor's services during the Revolutionary War were as follows:

While living the Camden District of South Carolina, Samuel Boone, Sr. furnished a substitute for military service, his son Samuel Boone, Jr. Samuel Boone, Jr. stated in his pension record, "I was not drafted for this tour, but my father Samuel Boone ... had been drafted, and I went ... as his substitute and served three months in SC Regiment."

## ELIGIBILITY CLAUSE

"Any woman is eligible for membership in the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution who is not less than eighteen years of age, and who is lineally descended from a man or woman who, with unfailing loyalty to the cause of American Independence, served as a sailor, or as a soldier or civil officer in one of the several Colonies or States, or in the United Colonies or States, or as a recognized patriot, or rendered material aid thereto; provided the applicant is personally acceptable to the Society." (Constitution, Article III, Section 1.)

Date of marriage may be substituted for dates of birth and death where such date proves the soldier to have been living during the Revolution and of a suitable age for service.

The following form of acknowledgement is required:

Applicant further says that the said Samuel Boone, Sr. (name of ancestor from whom eligibility is derived) is the ancestor mentioned in the foregoing application, and that the statements hereinafter set forth are true to the best of her knowledge and belief.

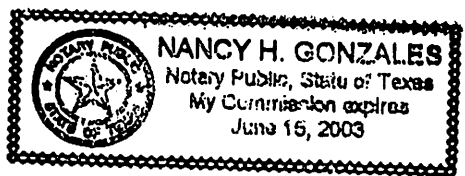
