FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE is before the Court upon the Petition For Dissolution of Marriage filed by the Husband, JOSEPH E. LANGLEY, JR., and the Counterpetition filed by the Wife, SHIRLEY A. LANGLEY. Present before the Court were the parties and their attorneys and after hearing the announcement of the parties regarding their Settlement and finding that the Settlement announced is in the best interest of the parties and the minor child, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over this cause, the parties thereto, and the subject matter thereof.
2. The marriage between the parties is hereby dissolved as it is found to be irretrievably broken.
3. The parties will share parental responsibility pursuant to the terms of the Statement of Shared Parental Responsibility attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, for their minor child, JOSEPH E. LANGLEY, III, born August 30, 1993. The Wife will be designated as the primary residential parent and the Husband will have the following rights of reasonable visitation and such other times as the parties may agree:

A. Every Wednesday evening from 6:00 P.M. until Thursday morning at 8:00 A.M.

B. Alternate weekends from Friday, at 6:00 P.M., until Sunday, at 6:00 P.M.

C. The first one-half of each Christmas vacation period as defined according to the school calendar for the Escambia County School system, until December 25th at 9:00 A.M.

D. Every Thanksgiving from Wednesday, at 6:00 P.M., until Friday, at 6:00 P.M. The Wife will have Thanksgiving weekend from Friday, at 6:00 P.M., regardless of the alternate weekend visitation above. The Wife will be able to have the child each Easter from Saturday, at 8:00 A.M., until Sunday, at 6:00 P.M., regardless of the alternate weekend arrangements.

E. Two solid weeks of visitation during the Husband's one-half of summer visitation as set forth in the Standard Visitation Schedule. At other times during the Husband's summer visitation schedule, the Wife will have the Husband's Wednesday evening and alternate weekend visitation with the minor child. During the Wife's one-half of the summer visitation pursuant to the Standard Visitation Schedule, she may designate up to two solid weeks with the child for vacation purposes. The Husband will have access on Wednesday evenings and alternate weekends during the other portions of the Wife's one-half of the Summer.

F. Once the minor becomes a student of the Escambia County School System, the Husband shall have one half of the spring break vacation as defined according to the school year for the Escambia County School System.

G. The Husband shall have visitation pursuant to all other provisions set forth in the Standard Visitation Schedule, not in conflict with the above.

H. The Husband's mother may provide child care services in her home either the day before or the day after the Husband's mid-week visitation if the Wife is not available to provide personal care for the child on either of those days.

4. The Husband shall pick up the minor child at the Wife's residence in order to commence his visitation and may have not more than one person with him who will remain in the car during the transfer process. The Wife will retrieve the child at the end of the Husband's visitation at his home and may have no more than one person who will remain in the car during the transfer process. Neither of the parties will discuss any problems during the transfer process.

5. Each party shall be required to provide an Itinerary including location and telephone number for any time that they wish to take the minor child out of town.

6. Any disputes as to visitation shall be referred to a certified family mediator prior to seeking judicial remedy.

7. The Husband shall pay to the Wife the sum of \$246.00 per month on a bi-monthly basis at the rate of \$123.00 on the 1st and 15th of each month until such time as the minor child reaches the age of 18 years, dies, marries, or otherwise becomes self-supporting. If the minor child is still in high school at the time he reaches his 18th birthday, but is diligently working to obtain his high school degree prior to his 19th birthday, then child

support shall continue until graduation from high school reaching the age of 19, whichever event occurs earlier.

8. As equitable distribution of the marital assets and debts, the Wife shall receive the following assets free from claims of the Husband and shall be solely responsible for the following debts and obligations and shall hold the Husband free and harmless from any default thereon:

1982 Nissan 280ZX, VCR, two chest of drawers, trundle bed, toaster, can opener, one-half of the dishes, one-half of the glasses, one-half of the flatware, posts and pans, coffee pot, tupperware, desk, lamp, Christmas Village, one-half of the towels, iron and ironing board, hair dryer, one-half of the child's pictures, one-quarter karat diamond ring, child's crib, entertainment center, and one phone. Responsibility for the debts to Montgomery Ward and VISA.

9. As equitable distribution of the marital assets and debts, the Husband shall receive the following assets free from claims of the Wife and shall be solely responsible for the following debts and obligations and shall hold the Wife free and harmless from any default thereon:

1992 Geo Prizm, together with any indebtedness associated with that vehicle, 19" television set, Sega Genesis and games, pole lamp, queen sized mattress set, oak high chair, changing table/dresser, toy box, one-half of the dishes, one-half of the glasses, one-half of the flatware, sandwich maker, coffee pot, one phone, dinette set, three piece sectional sofa, videos, Christmas ornaments, golf clubs, one-half of the towels, sheets for the queen sized bed and spread, one-half of the pictures of the child, and CD player. Responsibility for the debts to Gayfers, Circuit City, and VISA.

10. The parties shall also afford the other the opportunity to make copies of any videotapes of the child and duplicate

photographs of the child. The parties will share the expenses of this copying or duplication.



11. If health insurance for the minor child becomes available to the Husband through his employment, the Husband will obtain the insurance and share the premium expense pursuant to a pro-rata share as computed according to the child support guidelines.

12. Each party will be responsible for their own attorney's fees and costs of this action.

13. Neither party shall be entitled to receive alimony from the other.
