Permission form signed by the Historian General shall be signed by the chapter regent and sent to the approved authorized firm to purchase a grave marker.

## **Procedure for Granting Permission to Purchase DAR Insignia to Mark Member Graves**

The Historian General has granted permission to chapter regents to authorize the purchase of DAR Insignia grave markers to be placed at the site of the DAR member's interment.

**Guidelines:**

- The request for placement of a marker will be made to the chapter in which membership is/was held.
- The chapter regent is authorized to complete and sign a copy of the permission form issued by the Historian General. The signed permission form will be sent by the chapter to the chosen firm authorized by NSDAR to reproduce the DAR Insignia.
- After the marker is placed the chapter will send to the Office of the Historian General the DAR Member Marker Report Form (HG-1008). The membership file will be updated to record the location of the cemetery and date the marker was placed.
- These forms may be accessed through the NSDAR Members' Website, [www.members.dar.org](http://www.members.dar.org), select "Forms" and scroll to Historian General.
- If a member wishes to have the DAR Insignia etched into the head stone, please forward the request to the Office of the Historian General, so that we may send the insignia pattern and instructions for etching.
- If chapter membership cannot be verified in the chapter, please forward the request to the Office of the Historian General.
