during the American Revolution at York County, Pennsylvania assisted in establishing
American Independence, while acting in the capacity of (Soldier and Indian Scout) PUT PA

My ancestor's services during the Revolutionary War were as follows:

Militia Service - Capt. James Edgar's Company, York County, Pennsylvania

"John Rowland, private, in a detachment of the Sixth Class of York County Militia, under command of Capt. James Edgar in the actual service of the United States, guarding prisoners of war at Camp Security in York County, 10 October through 10 December 1781, for which service he was paid 5 pounds, and 5 pounds 10 shillings as bounty."

"John Rowland lost his mother when he was a small boy; his father Robert Rowland having married again, John was bound out to a Mr. Wells. When the revolutionary war broke out, Mr. Wells was drafted, and tried all over the country to get a substitute, but failing to find one, he hired John Rowland, who was then a mere boy. John served until the close of the war, and then was hired as an Indian scout to protect frontier settlers. He was under the command of Maj. McMahon, and served as a scout for three years along the Ohio River from Steubenville, Ohio to Louisville, Kentucky..."

ELIGIBILITY CLAUSE

"Any woman is eligible for membership in the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution who is not less than eighteen years of age, and who is lineally descended from a man or woman who, with unfailing loyalty to the cause of American Independence, served as a sailor, or as a soldier or civil officer in one of the several Colonies or States, or in the United Colonies or States, or as a recognized patriot, or rendered material aid thereto; provided the applicant is personally acceptable to the Society." (Constitution, Article III, Section 1.)

Date of marriage may be substituted for dates of birth and death where such date proves the soldier to have been living during the Revolution and of a suitable age for service.

The following form of acknowledgement is required:

Applicant further says that the said JOHN ROWLAND (name of ancestor from whom eligibility is derived) is the ancestor mentioned in the foregoing application, and that the statements hereinafter set forth are true to the best of her knowledge and belief.

This applicant also pledges allegiance to the United States of America and agrees to support its Constitution. This applies to applicants for membership within the United States of America and its territories.
