While living near Lebanon, PA, he enlisted in August 1776, served as private in Captain Henry Buehler's Pennsylvania Company and in Captain Fricker's Company under Colonel Klotz in the Flying Camp; was in a skirmish on Staten Island and battle of Fort Washington, where he was taken prisoner. He was held two weeks in a Presbyterian Church in New York City and eight weeks on a prison ship, then released on parole. His length of service was eight months.
