

I William Eaton of Fryeburg in the County of Oxford, & State of Maine, testify, depose & say, that I enlisted in the United States Continental Army on the 10th day of April, 1782, & that Joseph Frye Swan of this town enlisted at the same time - We served in different regiments. - In October, 1783, I was ordered to West Point - where I saw the said Joseph F. Swan, & entered the same Regiment, which was commanded by Colo. William Hull - his major was - Gibbs of Salem - The said Joseph F. Swan was then & there Quarter Master Sergeant & held that office till he was discharged on the 30th of June 1784 - I further testify that I am the identical William Eaton, now on the United States Pension Roll, - & that I have received regularly a pension under the Act of March 10, 1818 - & that my Pension Certificate is numbered 5516.
