

I Judah Dana Judge & as aforesaid do certify, that from the aforesaid statement of said Sworn and from the testimony of two Credible Witnesses both of whom declare on oath that they know him to serve in the revolutionary war as he has in his affidavit declared - it appears to my satisfaction that the said Joseph D. Sworn did serve in the revolutionary war as stated in the preceding declaration against the Common Enemy for the term of nine months, on the continental establishment and that from the testimony of four witnesses it appears he is in reduced circumstances & stands in need of assistance from his country for support - and I now transmit the proceedings & testimony taken & had before me to the Secretary for the department of War pursuant to the aforementioned act of Congress

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the seal of said Court - at Troy, N.Y. this twenty fifth day of July 1818.
