**FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND
JUDGMENT OF ABSOLUTE DIVORCE**

This matter comes before the court on October 1, 2013 for an *ex parte* default hearing upon the Plaintiff's Complaint for Absolute Divorce. The Plaintiff, Margaret Moerchen (hereinafter "Plaintiff"), appeared *pro se* before the court and the Defendant, John Robertson (hereinafter "Defendant"), failed to appear.

Based upon the pleadings, sworn testimony, and the entire record herein, the court makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and judgment of absolute divorce.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The court has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to D.C. Code § 11-1101(a).
2. The Plaintiff filed a Complaint for Absolute Divorce on July 1, 2013.
3. The Defendant was served with the Complaint and Summons via certified mail on July 26, 2013 and has failed to file an answer, enter an appearance or otherwise defend in this matter.
4. The Plaintiff filed an affidavit in support of default on August 26, 2013. A default was entered on August 26, 2013 and notices of a default hearing were mailed to the parties on August 27, 2013.
