

State of Virginia to wit.

On this 9th day of July in
the year 1878 before me James Simple a Judge
of the General Court of the State aforesaid
personally appears Thomas Elliott
aged 67 years

resident of the County
of Accomack

in the State aforesaid
who being by me first duly sworn
on the Holy Evangelists in due form of
Law doth in his oath make the following
declaration in order to obtain the provi-
sion made by the late Act of Congress

Entitled an Act to provide for cer-
tain persons engaged in the land and
naval services of the United States in
the Revolutionary war; that he the said
Thomas Elliott

in the
July — 1776 in the County of Accomack

in the State aforesaid enlisted
under Lieutenant Samuel Wafles of Capt Thomas
Palmer company of the 9th Virginia Regiment

on the
Continental Establishment commanded by
Colo. Hening at that time and afterwards by Colo.
Mathews
that he marched to Morris town to the north
where he joined the United States
