ELIGIBILITY CLAUSE

"Any woman is eligible for membership in the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution who is not less than eighteen years of age, and who is lineally descended from a man or woman who, with unfailing loyalty to the cause of American Independence, served as a sailor, or as a soldier or civil officer in one of the several Colonies or States, or in the United Colonies or States, or as a recognized patriot, or rendered material aid thereto; provided the applicant is personally acceptable to the Society." (Constitution, Article III, Section 1.)

Applicant must provide documentation proving lineal descent for each statement of birth, marriage and death. This shall include a birth certificate naming her parents. Data submitted as proof is subject to DAR standards and interpretation. This applies to "new ancestors" and previously accepted lineage for which documentation was not required at the time of acceptance.

Applicant further says that the said John Rowland (name of ancestor) is her ancestor and that the statements set forth are true to the best of her knowledge and belief.

This applicant also pledges allegiance to the United States of America and agrees to support its Constitution. This applies to applicants for membership within the United States of America and its territories.

The said John Rowland ✓ who resided during the American Revolutionary at York County, Pennsylvania assisted in establishing American Independence while acting in the capacity of (Soldier and Indian Scout)

PUT PA

My ancestor's services during the Revolutionary War were as follows:

Militia Service-Capt. James Edgar's Co., York Co.,PA., Pvt. in detachment of Sixth Class of York Co. Militia, under Capt. Edgar in actual service of the US, guarding prisoners at Capt Security in York Co. Oct. through 10 Dec. 1781, paid for service, 5 pounds & 5 pounds 10 shillings as bounty. As a child was bound out to a Mr. Wells who in turn hired John to substitute for him in the war. Later served as a Indian to protect frontier settlers. He was under the command of Maj. McMahon and then served as a scout for three years along the Ohio River from Steubenville, Ohio to Louisville, KY
