Bettes, Nathaniel, Sandisfield. Return of enlisted into Continental Army fr Col. Ashley's regt. (yr, not given); residence, Sandisfield; enlisted for town of Sandisfield; joined Capt. Allen's Co., Col. Wigglesworth's regt.; enlistment 3 yrs; reported mustered by Trueman Wheeler, Muster Master; also Sergeant Major, Capt. Noah Allen's Co., Col. Calvin Smith's (late Wigglesworth's) regt.; Continental Army pay accounts for service from April 1777 to 10 April 1779; reported from Sergeant to Sergeant Major 1 April 1779; promoted to Ensign 10 April 1779; also Sergeant, Capt. Allen's Co., Col. Edward Wigglesworth's (4th) regt.; muster rolls for March and May, 1778, dated Valley Forge; also muster roll for June 1778, dated Camp Greenwich; also, Capt. Allen's Co., Maj. Porter's (late Wigglesworth's) regt.; muster roll for March and April, 1779, dated Providence; reported transferred to Colonel's Co.; also, Sergeant Major, Colonel's Co., commanded by Capt. Lieut. Christopher Woodbridge, Col. Wigglesworth's regt. muster roll for March and April 1779.

ELIGIBILITY CLAUSE

"Any woman is eligible for membership in the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution who is not less than eighteen years of age, and who is descended from a man or woman who, with unfailing loyalty to the cause of American Independence, served as a sailor, or as a soldier or civil officer in one of the several Colonies or States, or in the United Colonies or States, or as a recognized patriot, or rendered material aid thereto; provided the applicant is personally acceptable to the Society." (Constitution, Article III, Section 1.)

Marriage in every instance means legal and lawful marriage. Date of marriage may be substituted for dates of birth and death where such date proves the soldier to have been living during the Revolution and of a suitable age for service.

The following form of acknowledgement is required:

Applicant further says that the said Nathaniel Bettes (name of ancestor from whom eligibility is derived) is the ancestor mentioned in the foregoing application, and that the statements hereinafter set forth are true to the best of her knowledge and belief.

This applicant also pledges allegiance to the United States of America and agrees to support its Constitution. This applies to applicants for membership within the United States of America and its territories.
