ANCESTOR'S SERVICES

The said Nehemiah Andrews ^{Hampshire} who resided during the American Revolution at Bernardston, (Franklin County) Massachusetts assisted in establishing American Independence, while acting in the capacity of Volunteer Minute Man responding to the 19 April 1775 Lexington Alarm and serving two years and nine months as artificer. PVT-MA

My ancestor's services during the Revolutionary War were as follows:

With the rank of Private, as a Minute Man marched with Cpt. Agrippa Wells' Company in Col. Samuel William's Regiment to Cambridge, Massachusetts in response to the Lexington Alarm, serving ten days from 20 April 1775 to 1 May 1775. He enlisted 1 May 1775 in Cpt. Agrippa Wells' Company, Col. Asa Whitcomb's Regiment, and also in Cpt. Pollard's Company, Col. Asa Whitcomb's Regiment. He served a total of two years and nine months. He was an artificer or carpenter. He was at White Plains at Springfield, Massachusetts. His widow Elizabeth Scott Andrews applied for a pension on 6 April, 1839 number 25354 which was granted.

ELIGIBILITY CLAUSE

"Any woman is eligible for membership in the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution who is not less than eighteen years of age, and who is descended from a man or woman who, with unflinching loyalty to the cause of American Independence, served as a sailor, or as a soldier or civil officer in one of the several Colonies or States, or in the United Colonies or States, or as a recognized patriot, or rendered material aid thereto; provided the applicant is personally acceptable to the Society." (Constitution, Article III, Section 1.)

Date of marriage may be substituted for dates of birth and death where such date proves the soldier to have been living during the Revolution and of a suitable age for service.

The following form of acknowledgement is required:

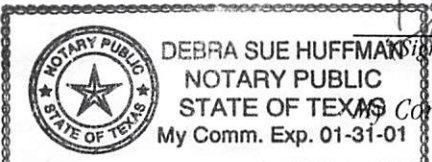
